Do you have a VISA debit or credit card? If so, purchases you make can be free money to our parking lot fund with businesses that are in this program. If you use a debit card you would run the purchase as a Credit. The program is working with MasterCard to make those purchases eligible.

This does not cost you any money, the business that is in the program donates based on your purchase amount.

We only have 9 people signed up for this program and we made \$71.89 in 2015, so if we could get a majority of our congregation to utilize this program, just think how this could boost our parking lot fund.

Easter Week is Almost Here!
Maundy Thursday Worship
 Thursday, March 24th, 7:00pm (potluck 6:00pm)

On Maundy Thursday we will be holding a Tenebrae Service. What Does Tenebrae Mean?

Tenebrae (Latin for 'shadows' or 'darkness') is a Christian religious service celebrated on the evening of Maundy Thursday. The distinctive ceremony of Tenebrae is the gradual extinguishing of candles during a series of readings.

The people who read Scripture snuff out candles when they finish their passage to represent the flight of the disciples and the approach of the dark hate of Jesus' enemies and the Passion of Christ. When the last passage has been read, the room is completely dark, and recalls the days when Jesus was in the tomb.

Finally, we relight a single candle to represent the hope of the prophecy of Easter.
